FOUR PERSONS CHARGED IN CONNECTION WITH THE ROBBERY AND MURDER OF
LIEUTENANT-GENERAL (RETIRED) SAMUEL OMAR WILLIAMS

The Attorney-General and Minister of Justice has instructed the Sierra Leone Police (SLP) to prefer charges against Ibrahim Kalokoh (alias Kartel), Festus Mansaray (alias Bigman), Alhaji Steven Bangura (alias stegal), and Alpha Umaru Jalloh (alias Maju) in respect of the robbery and death of Lieutenant-General (Retired) Samuel Omar Williams on the 22nd December, 2016 at his residence at Umuels Drive, Devil Hole, in the Waterloo Judicial District in the Western Area of Sierra Leone.

All accused persons were charged with one count of conspiracy. Ibrahim Kalokoh (alias Kartel), Festus Mansaray (alias Bigman) and Alhaji Steven Bangura (alias stegal) were also charged with three-counts of robbery with aggravation, and a count of murder; and Alpha Umaru Jalloh (alias Maju) stand charged with the offence of accessory after the fact to the three-counts of robbery with aggravation and the count of murder.

Arrest warrants have been issued for the apprehension of Ibrahim Jusu (alias Sean Paul) and one Yok in connection with the robbery and death of the Lieutenant-General (Retired) Samuel Omar Williams. The public is therefore encouraged to help provide useful information to the SLP leading to the arrest and prosecution of the said Ibrahim Jusu (alias Sean Paul) and Yok.

The general public is assured that all those responsible for the death of Lieutenant-General (Retired) Samuel Omar Williams will face the full penalty of the law.
